**Welcome Vivian and Michael Krigline!** Michael and Vivian Krigline are cross-cultural ministers, touching lives from their base in South Carolina both locally and globally. They are active in ministry to international students, refugees, and the larger international community in central SC, while also active as leaders for a Hong Kong based charity (which they have been a part of since 1999). As John Wesley said, the world is my parish, and the Kriglines love how technology allows them to actively minister in Asia, South America and the US!

Michael grew up in Georgia and Ohio (Hoover High), earning his BA (Sociology and Social Welfare) at Eastern University outside Philadelphia. After studying Mandarin in China from 1985-87, he moved to Columbia to start a seminary degree at Columbia International University. He met Vivian and married in 1989.

Michael finished his MA (Intercultural Studies and Teaching English as a Foreign Language) in 1999. In 2000, Vivian retired from the City of

Columbia (after 28 years) and soon started a second career in East Asia. From 2000 to 2015, Michael taught at various Asian universities. In 2015, he was recruited as General Executive Director for a charity based in Hong Kong. For family reasons, he and Vivian moved back to the US in the summer of 2019. Michael is still working for the HK charity, as well as working for other US-based charities on various levels primarily International Friendship Ministries.
